

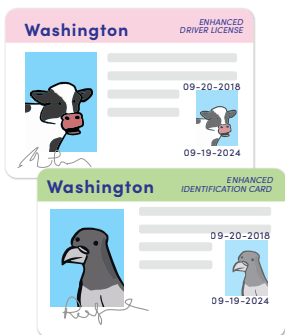

### You may have heard of **REAL ID**.

It's a U.S. law established in 2005, requiring all states to comply with new identification standards for air travel and entrance to some federal facilities like military bases.

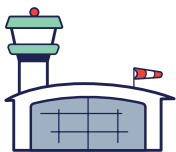




# The Basics

When **REAL ID** goes into effect in **May 2023**, you'll need more than a driver's license to fly. Options include a **passport, a passport card, an enhanced driver's license (EDL), green card, and many others.**

Go to **ID2023WA.com** to find out if you're ready for May 2023.



## Don't fly?

You're covered. A REAL ID-compliant ID is not required to access federal courts, Social Security offices, national parks, and health care facilities—among others.

Other avenues of travel, such as driving across state lines or taking a train, do not require a REAL ID-compliant ID. Standard driver's licenses and ID cards will work.



## Standard Driver's License and ID

Your standard driver's license is still valid. Washington will continue to issue standard driver's licenses and ID cards for driving and/or identification. Using a standard driver's license or ID card after May 3, 2023 does not indicate citizenship or immigration status.
